

## Monthly Meeting Minutes

### 1<sup>st</sup> Precinct Community Council

April 27<sup>th</sup>, 2017 6:30 PM

Previous meeting minutes not read

Community Council Secretary Sarah Elbatanouny called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm.

#### **First Precinct Deputy Inspector IOCCO Report:**

Crime statistics read are based on current 28 day period compared to the same 28 day period last year.

**Overall crime** decrease by over 5 % with 28 crimes vs 295 for the 28 day period.

**Rape:** rape is down 100 % with zero reported in the 28 day period vs 2 the same as last year.

**Robberies for the week** are also down with 0 vs 4 for the same 28 period.

**Felony assaults** remind the same with 7 reported the same number the 28 day period.

**Burglaries** decrease substantially by over 83 % with 2 versus 12 for the same 28 day period.

**Grand Larcenies** decreased by 17 % with 57 vs 69 for the same 28 day period.

**GLAs** for the 28 day period, with 3 grand larcenies compared to 2 in the last 28 day period.

Inspector IOCCO discussed the ongoing investigation of the dispute between two men selling tickets by Battery Park that led to the shooting of an innocent bystander. This incident happened about 3:15 p.m. near Battery Place and Washington Street, close to Manhattan's Financial District.

A woman in her 30s, an innocent bystander, was walking down Washington Street when she was hit in the ankle by a stray bullet, officials said. While in the meeting it was announced that an arrest was made.
